We personally invite you to join us as we follow the steps Jesus took, listen to the words He spoke and experience the gift of salvation He gave.





The Sunday before He was crucified, Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey. The people waved palm branches and said "Hosanna in the Highest!"


QUESTION:

Jesus told His followers that the greatest commandment was to love God with all their heart, soul, mind and strength. He is the one true God!


QUESTION:

READ: Mark 14:1–11


A few days before Jesus' crucifixion, a woman poured expensive ointment on His feet. This was likely the most valuable thing she owned!

Before lesus was arrested, He ate the Passover meal with His disciples and then went to the garden to pray. Jesus knew He was going to die and asked God for help.


QUESTION:

Revelation 7:9–12



After Jesus died, they put His body in a tomb. Spend a minute or two in silence to remind your children He didn't speak or move or breathe.


QUESTION:

Jesus is alive!


QUESTION:


